

The BioCryst **SPARK** Award

Supporting Pioneering advances in Angioedema Research & Knowledge

The BioCryst SPARK Award is a \$50,000 grant over 1–2 years supporting independent preclinical and/or clinical research that advances the science of angioedema.

The Award is designed to fuel the next generation of angioedema researchers—investigators with bold ideas, rigorous science, and the drive to translate discovery into meaningful impact for patients.



Who Can Apply

- ▶ Earlier-stage investigators with an MD, DO, PharmD, PhD, or equivalent terminal degree—typically within ten years of terminal training or first independent appointment.
- ▶ Must be affiliated with a U.S.-based academic institution, hospital, or recognized research organization and serve as Principal Investigator. Open to U.S.-based investigators only.
- ▶ One application per cycle. Commercial entities and CROs applying on behalf of investigators are not eligible. Career interruptions may be disclosed and considered in a fair review.



What We Fund

Only independent preclinical and/or clinical research related to angioedema. Product-only requests and head-to-head comparisons will not be considered. BioCryst does not influence study design, conduct, analysis, or publication.



Application Cycle

- ▶ All materials must be submitted in English by the deadline.
